



**Installation instructions for BrIcc V2.0 on Windows NT/ME/2000/XP**  
30 September 2005

Download and execute the self-extracting installation archive, [BrIccWin32.exe](#) that will install the BrIcc program, data files and the program manual on your computer. It will also set the *BrIccHome* environment variable required for the program to locate the data files.

The installation program will prompt for a destination folder, where all the files will be installed:




To complete the installation, press the close button on the second screen shown below.




The installation program will set the value of the *BrIccHome* environment variable to the installation directory. This directory will be added to the *Path* variable, so the program can be used from any directory on the computer. To work with ENSDF files, it is preferable to use the Command Prompt and change the working directory, where the ENSDF files are.

BrIcc needs at least 117 columns to list all E1-E5 and M1-M5 multipolarities. The default width of 80 columns of the Command Prompt window can be changed by right clicking on its title bar shown below.



Selecting Defaults will allow changing the default values, shown in the following picture:



To uninstall BrIcc use the uninstall link in the BrIcc program group.
