^{81}Nb has not yet been observed. In 1999, Janas et al. deduced an upper limit for its half-life of 80 ns ([1999Ja02](#)). Suzuki et al. set a more stringent limit of 40 ns for the half-life in 2017 ([2017Su26](#)).
