

## $^{178}\text{Er}$

In 2012, Kurcewicz et al. reported the observation of  $^{178}\text{Er}$  in “Discovery and cross-section measurement of neutron-rich isotopes in the element range from neodymium to platinum with the FRS” (2012Ku26). A 1 GeV/nucleon  $^{238}\text{U}$  from the GSI SIS-18 synchrotron impinged on a thick beryllium target and projectile fragmentation and projectile fission fragments were analysed with the projectile Fragment Separator FRS. The cross section for the production of  $^{178}\text{Er}$  was measured to be  $5.5\pm 0.9$  nb as listed in a table.
