Isomerism was first established in ^{118}Sb by M.Lindner and I.Pperlman in 1948 at Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, Berkeley, California ([1948Li02](#)). The 5.01 h isomeric level by itself had been measured earlier ([1947Co04](#)).
