Isomerism was first established in ^{126}Sb by R.L.Hahn and J.M.Miller in 1961 at Brookhaven National Laboratory, Upton, New York ([1961Ha39](#)). The 19.15 m isomeric level by itself had been measured earlier ([1956Fr31](#)).
