Isomerism was first established in ^{121}Te by J.E.Edwards and M.L.Pool in 1946 at The Ohio State University, Columbus, Ohio ([1946Ed03](#)). The 164.7 d isomeric level by itself had been measured earlier ([1939Se05](#)).
