

**$^{132}\text{Te-1}$**

The 28.5  $\mu\text{s}$  isomer of  $^{132}\text{Te}$  was first observed in 1973 by J.McDonald and A.Kerek at the Studsvik Science Research Laboratory, Nyköping, Sweden ([1973Mc09](#)).
