

### $^{133}\text{Te-1}$

Isomerism was first established in  $^{133}\text{Te}$  by S.G.Prussin and W.W.Meinke in 1965 at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan ([1965Pr08](#)). The 55.4 m isomeric level by itself had been measured earlier ([1940Wu05](#)).
