Isomerism was first established in ^{137}Ce by A.R.Brosi and B.H.Ketelle in 1955 at Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, Berkeley, California ([1955Br05](#)). The 34.4 h isomeric level by itself had been measured earlier ([1948Ch03](#)).
