Isomerism was first established in ¹⁹⁹Bi by A.Siivola et al. in 1964 at the University of Uppsala, Uppsala, Sweden ([1964Si11](#)). The 24.7 m isomeric level by itself had been measured earlier ([1950Ne77](#)).
