

### **<sup>199</sup>Po-1**

The 4.17 m isomer of <sup>199</sup>Po was first observed in 1965 by C.Brun et al. at the Institut de Physique Nucléaire, Orsay, France ([1965Br17](#)). This half-life had previously been assigned to <sup>197</sup>Po ([1964Br23](#)).
