

$^{195}\text{At-1}$

The 143 ms isomer of ^{195}At was first observed in 1999 by Y.Tagaya et al. at The Institute of Physical and Chemical Research (RIKEN), Wako-shi, Japan ([1999Ta20](#)). Previously, the half-lives of two states in ^{195}At were only reported in a conference proceeding ([1995Le15](#)).
