The 103 ns isomer of ²³⁷Pu was first observed in 1969 by N.L.Lark et al. at the Niels Bohr Institute, Copenhagen, Denmark ([1969La14](#)). It should be noted that this isomer is not included in the NUBASE2020 evaluation ([2021Ko07](#)).
