Isomerism was first established in ²⁴⁴Am by S.E.Vandenbosch and P.Day in 1962 at Argonne National Laboratory, Argonne, Illinois ([1962Va08](#)). The 26.13 m isomeric level by itself had been measured earlier ([1950St61](#)).
