

## $^{248}\text{Bk-1}$

Isomerism was first established in  $^{248}\text{Bk}$  by J. Milsted et al. in 1965 at Argonne National Laboratory, Argonne, Illinois ([1965Mi08](#)). The 23.7 h isomeric level by itself had been measured earlier ([1956Hu27](#)).
