



$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{53}\text{Cr}(n,\text{tot.})$



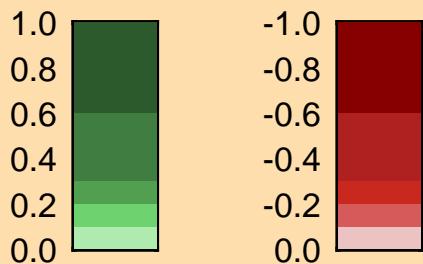
Ordinate scales are % relative standard deviation and barns.

Abscissa scales are energy (eV).


σ vs. E for $^{53}\text{Cr}(n,\text{tot.})$


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{53}\text{Cr}(\text{n},\text{el.})$



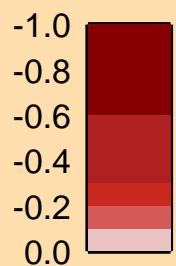
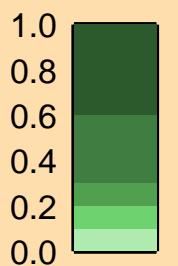




$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{53}\text{Cr}(n,2n)$



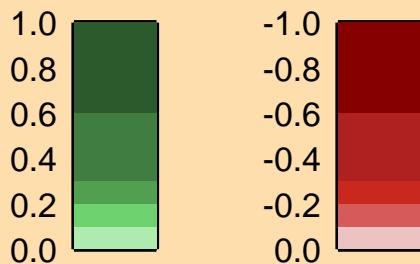


σ vs. E for $^{53}\text{Cr}(n,2n)$


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{53}\text{Cr}(n,\gamma)$
