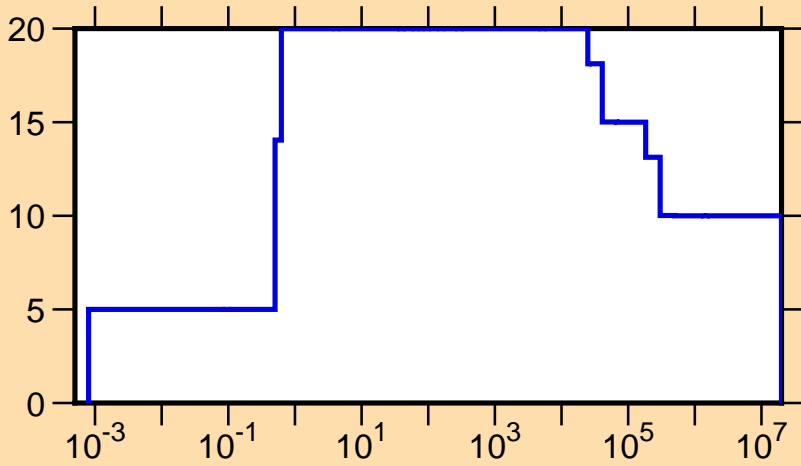
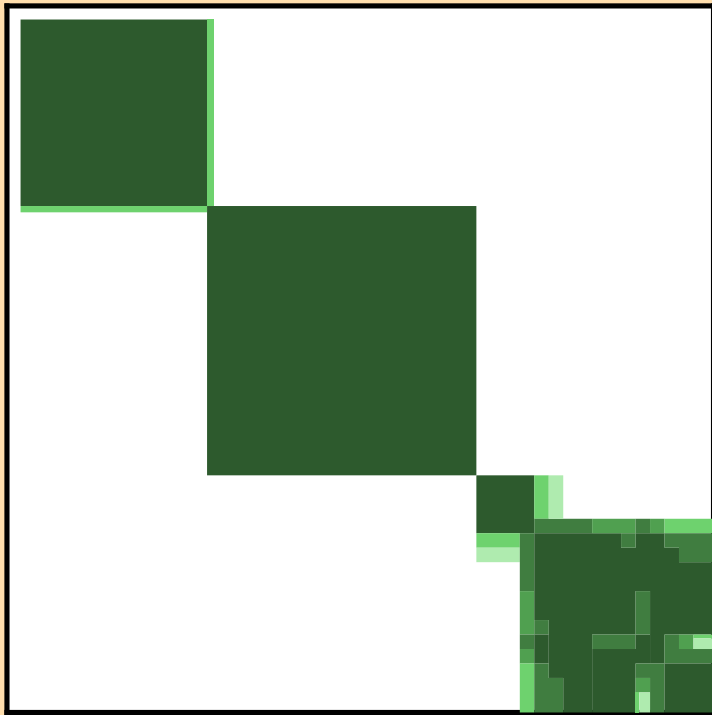


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{242}\text{Am}(n,\text{el.})$

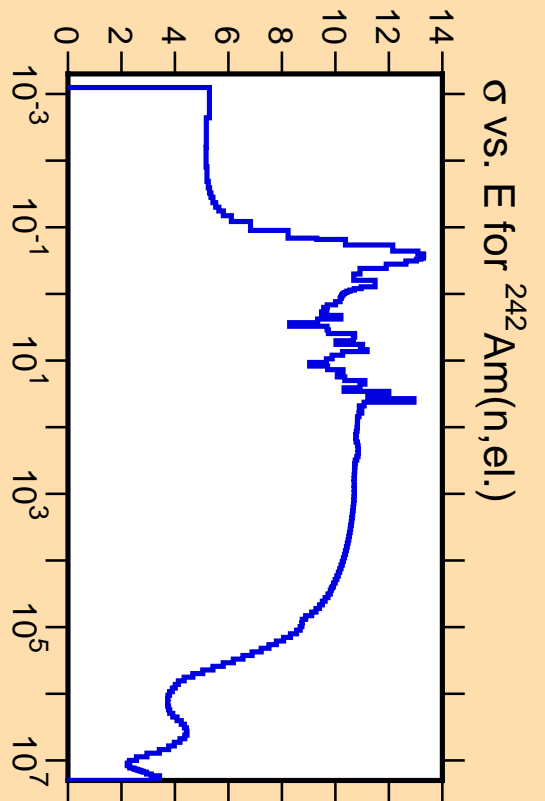
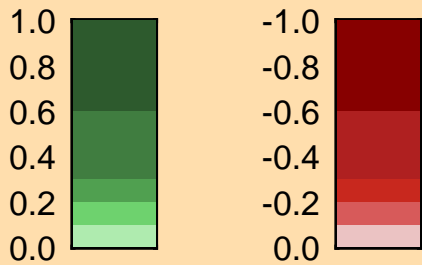


Ordinate scales are % relative standard deviation and barns.

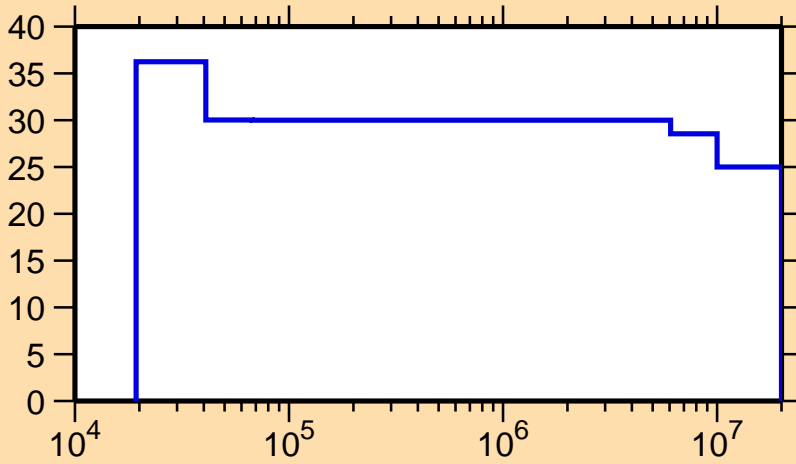
Abscissa scales are energy (eV).

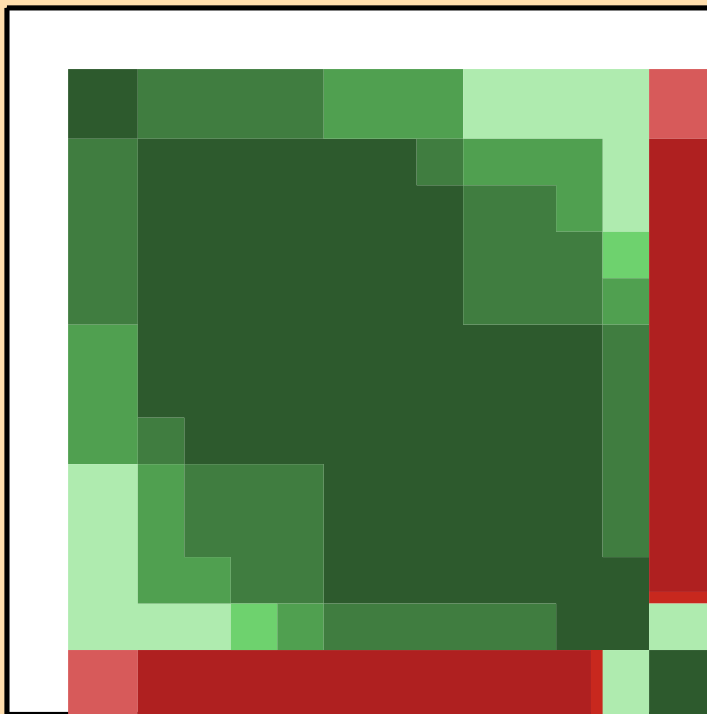


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{242}\text{Am}(n,\text{inel.})$

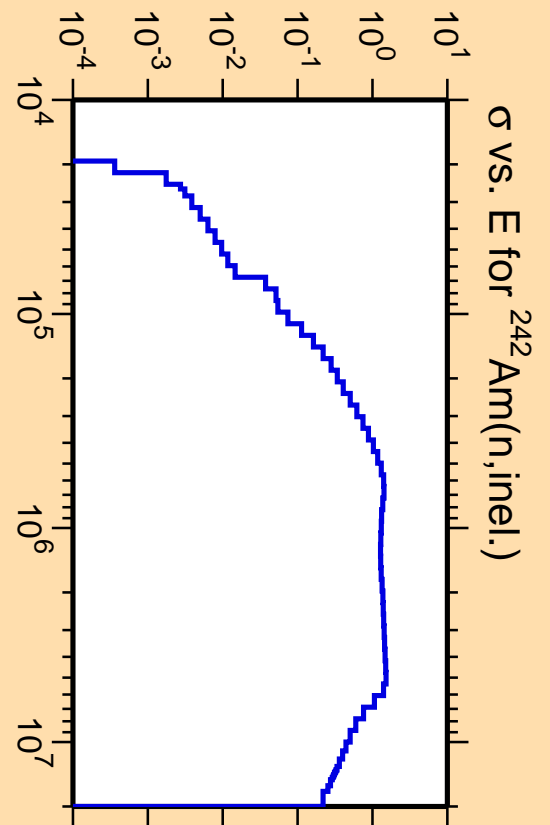

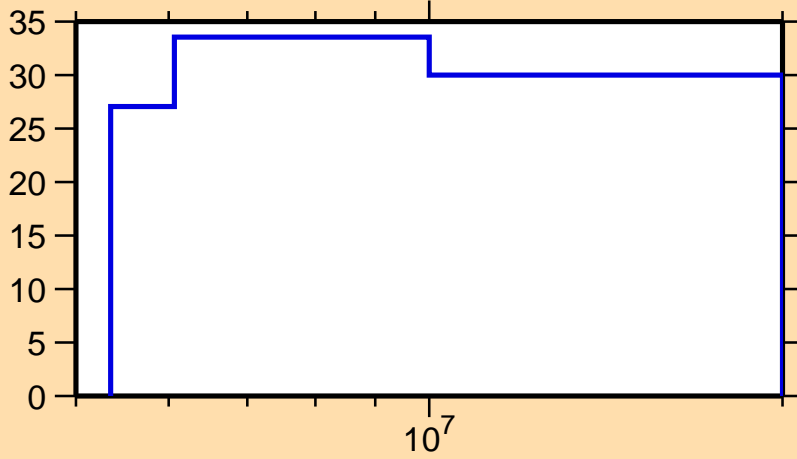

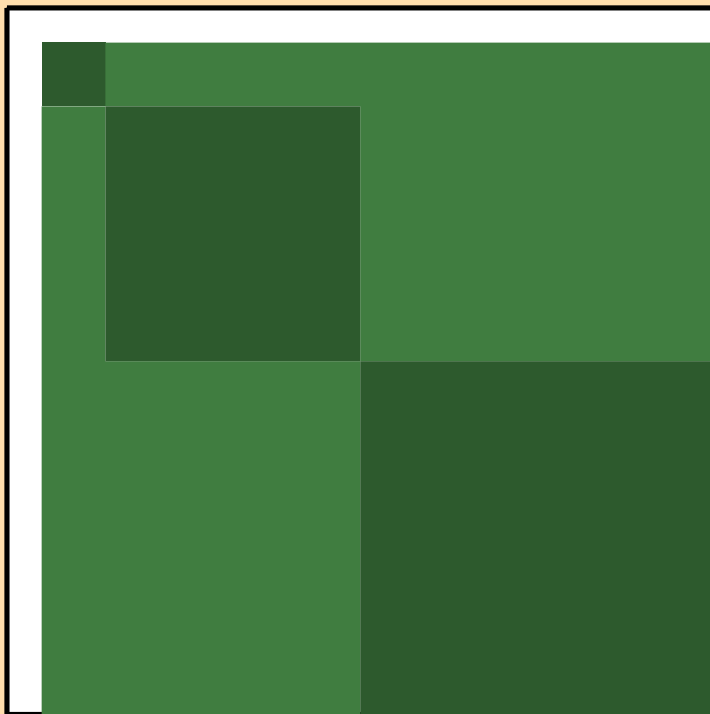


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{242}\text{Am}(n,2n)$

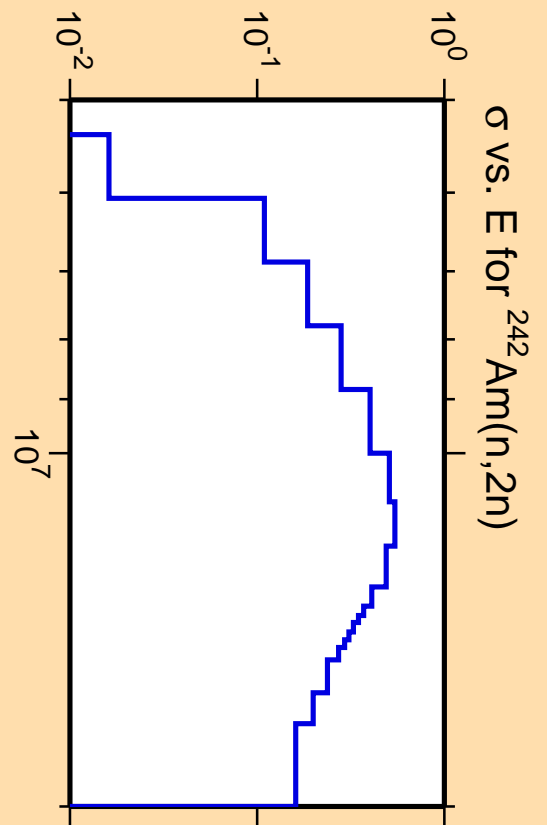

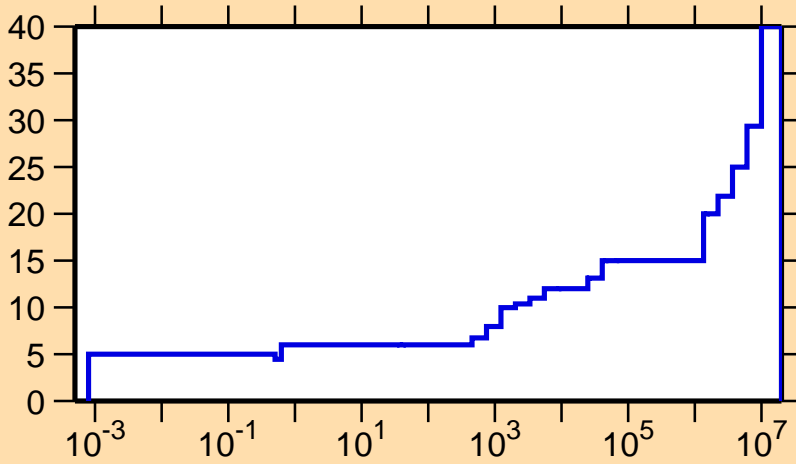

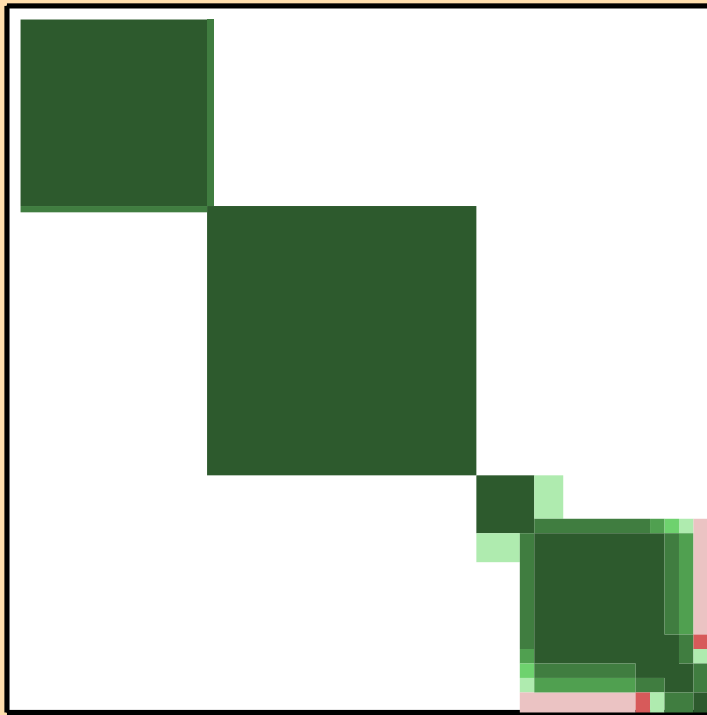


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{242}\text{Am}(n,f)$

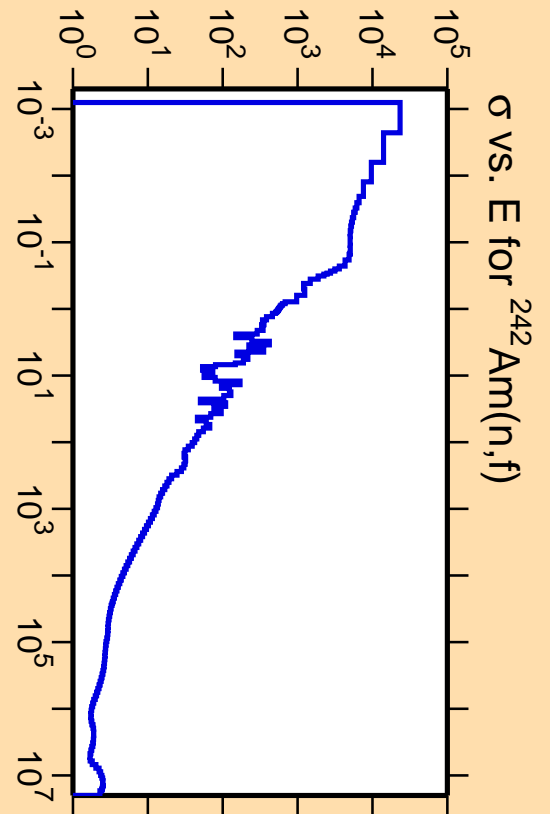

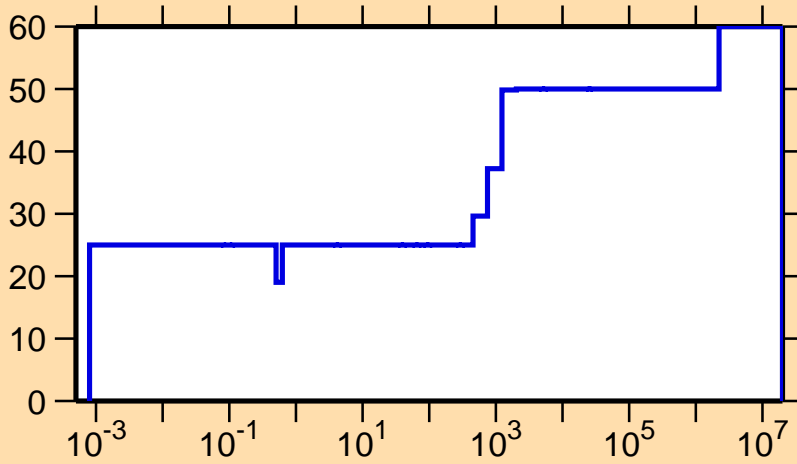

σ vs. E for $^{242}\text{Am}(n,f)$

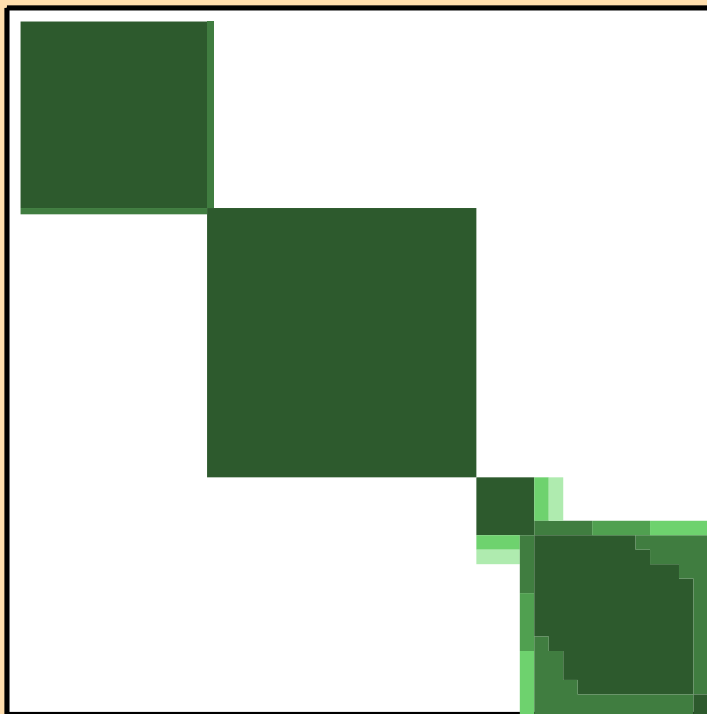
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{242}\text{Am}(n,\gamma)$
