



$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{24}\text{Mg}(n,\text{tot.})$




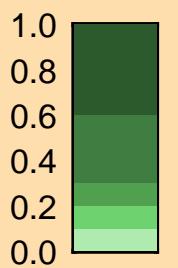


σ vs. E for $^{24}\text{Mg}(n,\text{tot.})$


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{24}\text{Mg}(\text{n},\text{el.})$



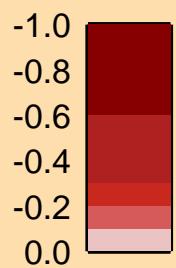
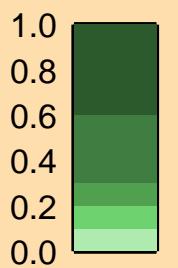


σ vs. E for $^{24}\text{Mg}(\text{n},\text{el.})$




$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{24}\text{Mg}(n,2n)$







σ vs. E for $^{24}\text{Mg}(n,2n)$





