



$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{99}\text{Tc}(n,\text{tot.})$



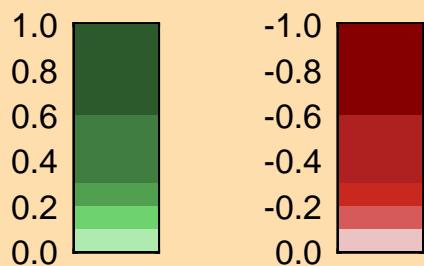
Ordinate scales are % relative standard deviation and barns.

Abscissa scales are energy (eV).


σ vs. E for $^{99}\text{Tc}(n,\text{tot.})$


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{99}\text{Tc}(n,\text{el.})$







σ vs. E for $^{99}\text{Tc}(n,\text{el.})$




$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{99}\text{Tc}(n,\text{inel.})$

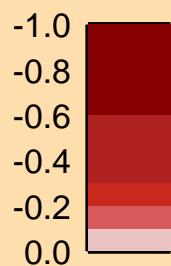
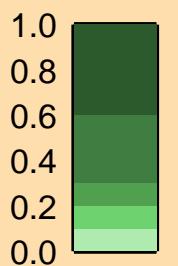




$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{99}\text{Tc}(n,2n)$



σ vs. E for $^{99}\text{Tc}(n,2n)$




