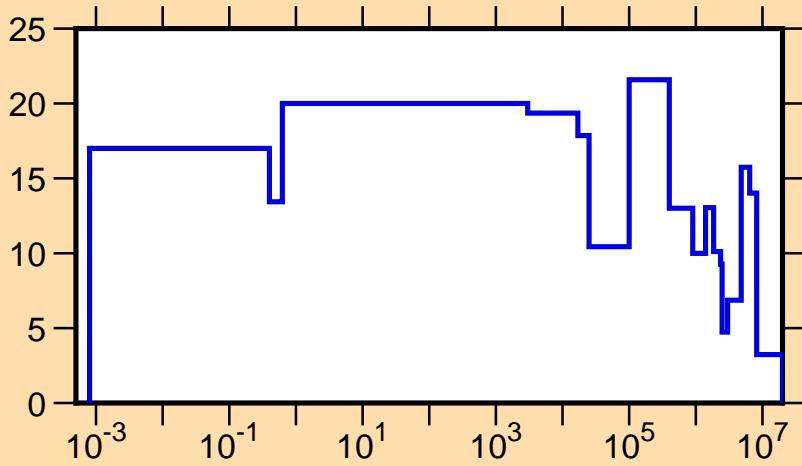
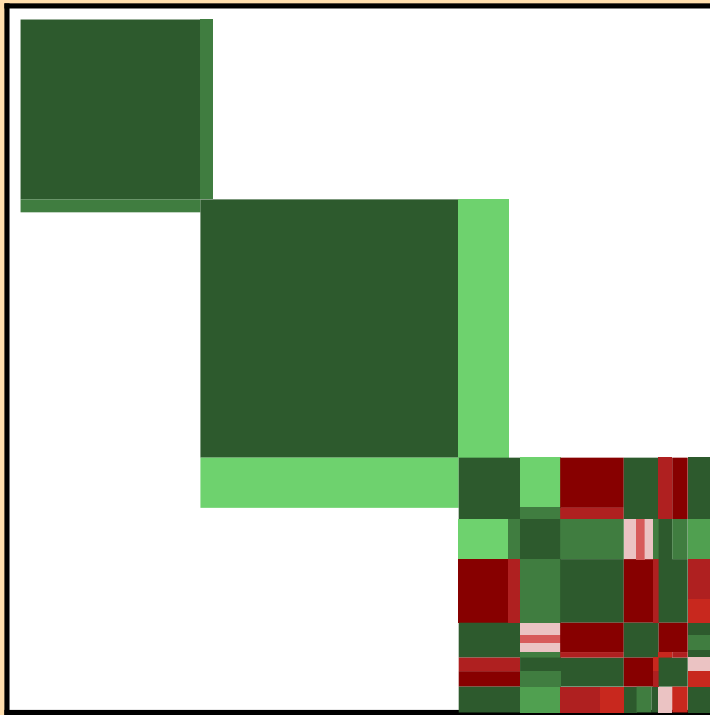


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{170}\text{Er}(n,\text{el.})$

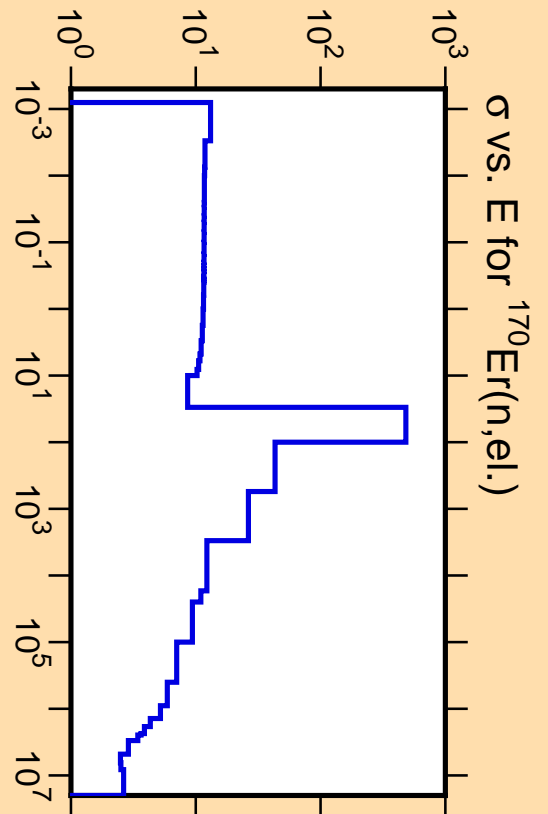


Ordinate scales are % relative standard deviation and barns.

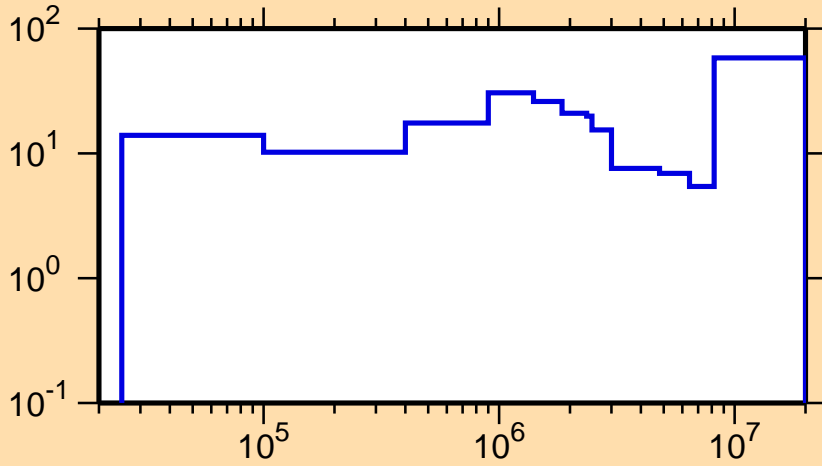
Abscissa scales are energy (eV).

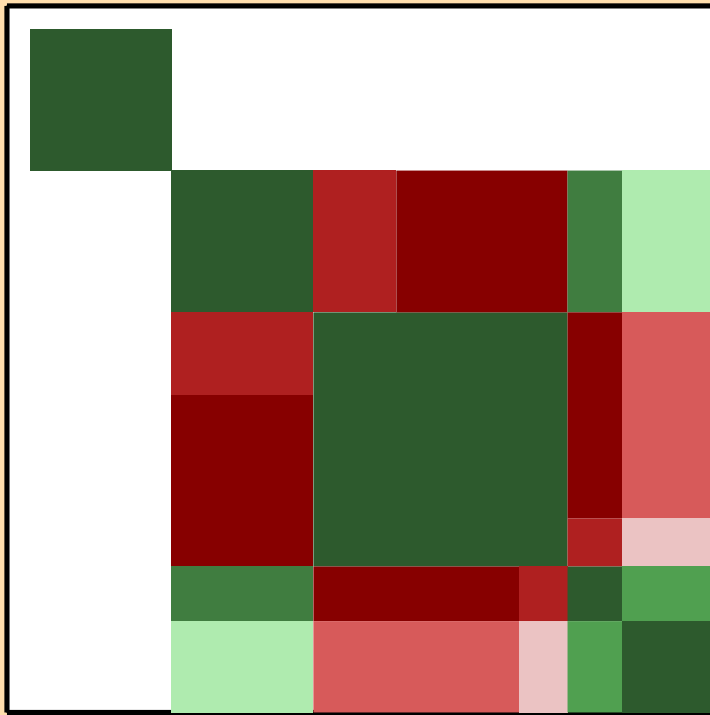


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{170}\text{Er}(n,\text{inel.})$

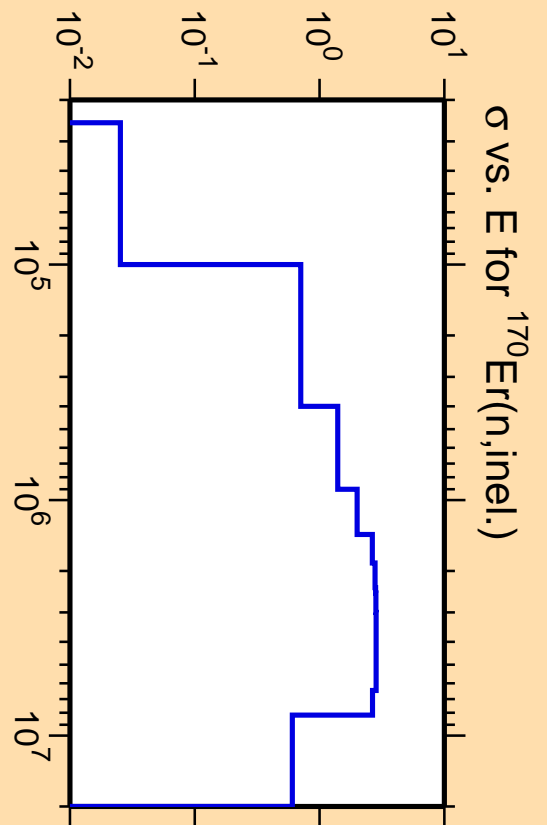

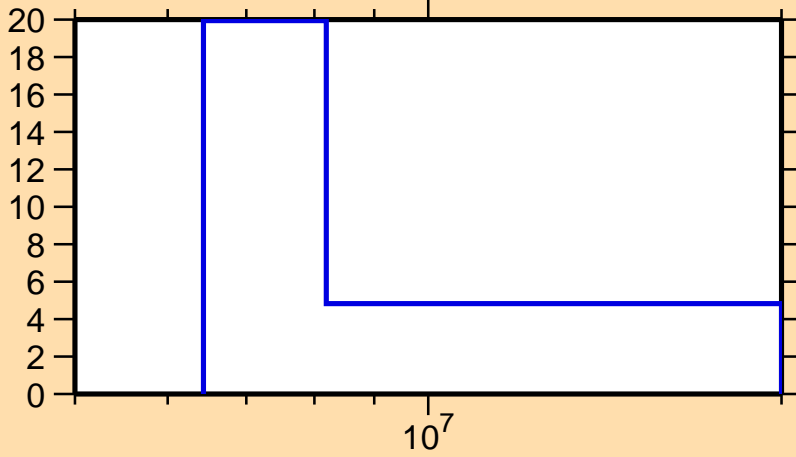

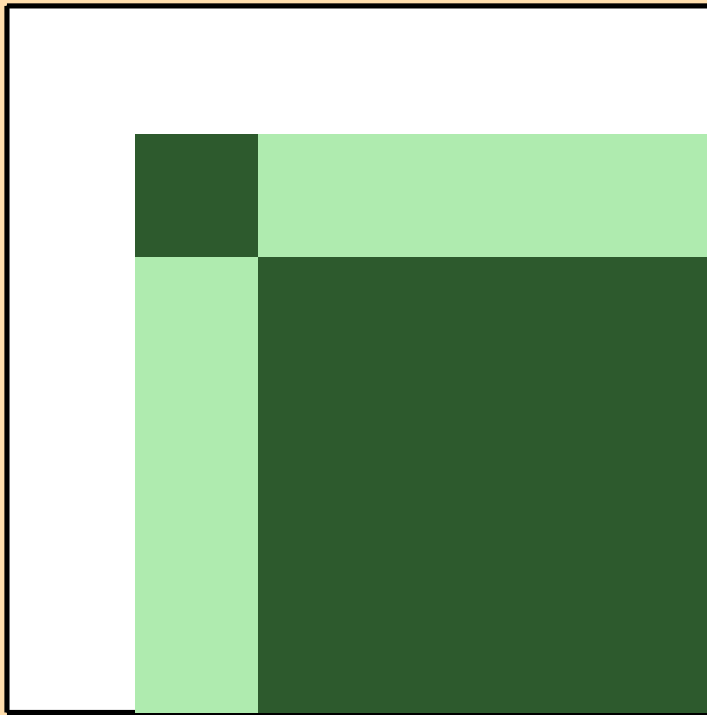
$\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{170}\text{Er}(n,\text{inel.})$

$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{170}\text{Er}(n,2n)$

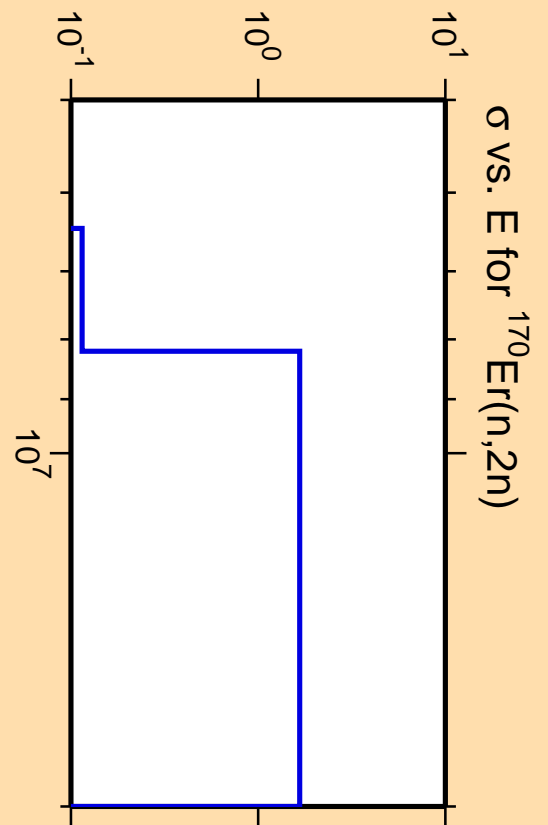

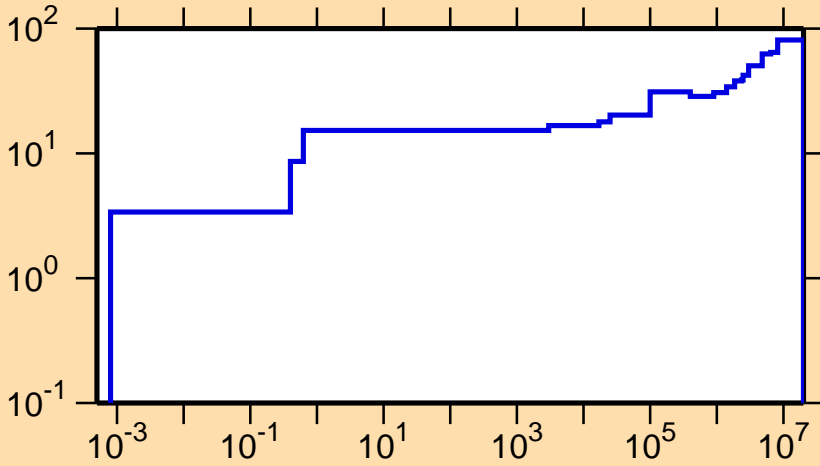

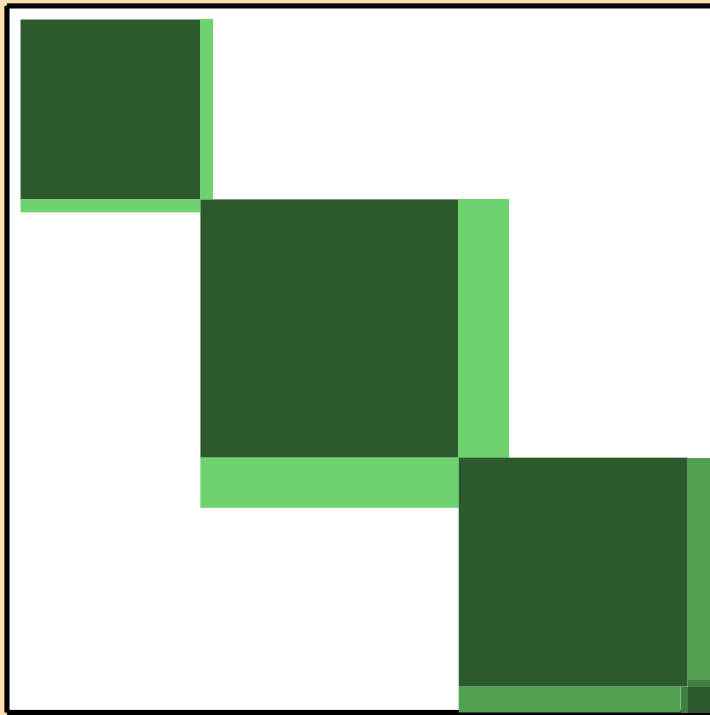
$\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{170}\text{Er}(n,2n)$

$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{170}\text{Er}(n,\gamma)$

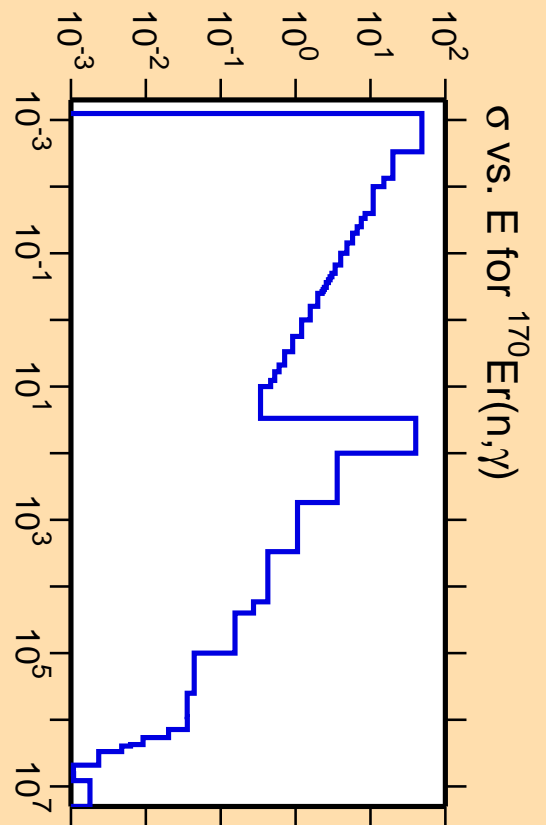
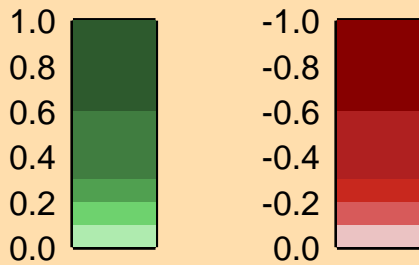
