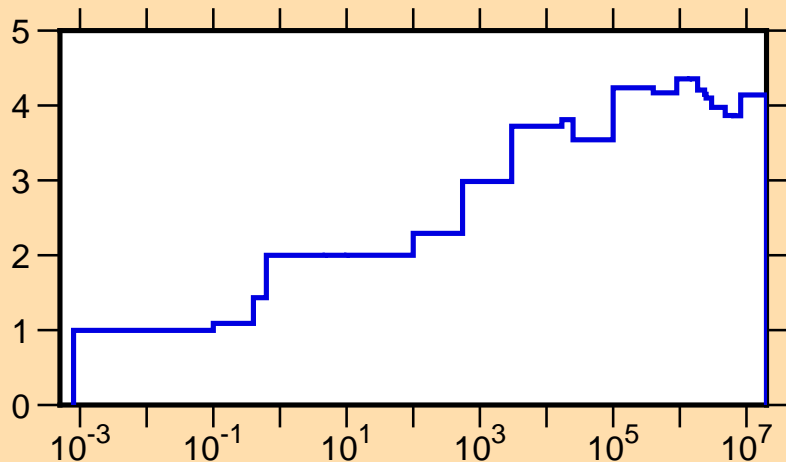
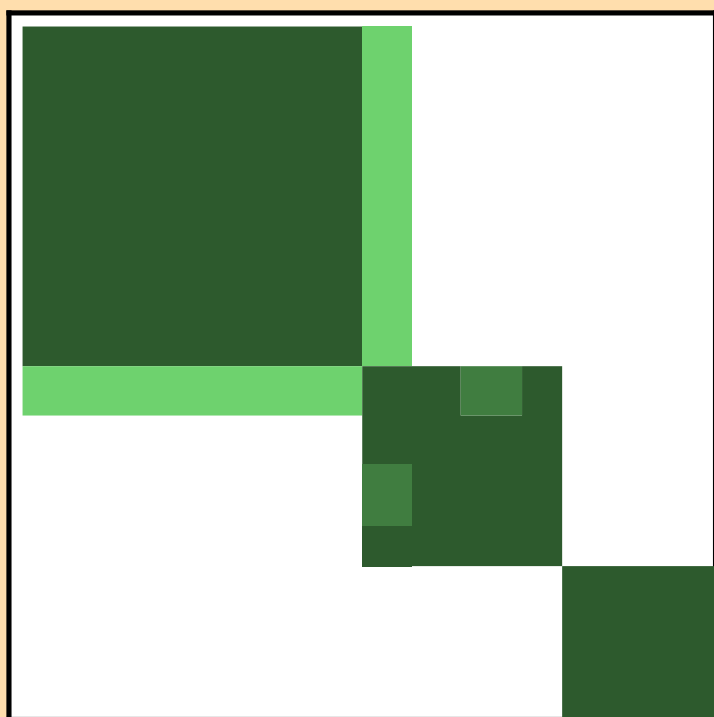


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{209}\text{Bi}(n,\text{tot.})$

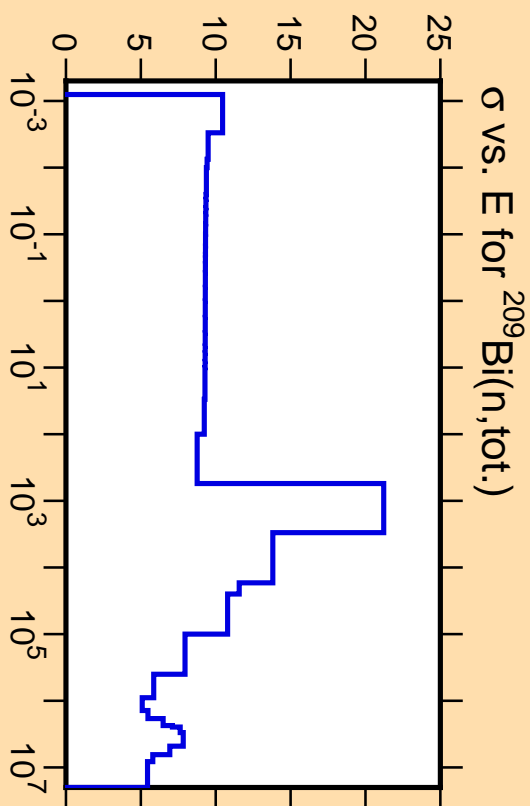
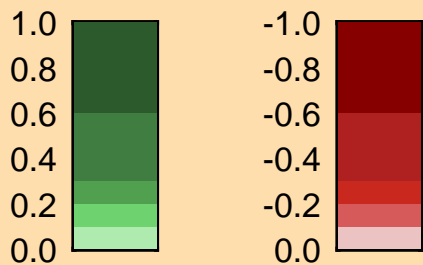


Ordinate scales are % relative standard deviation and barns.

Abscissa scales are energy (eV).

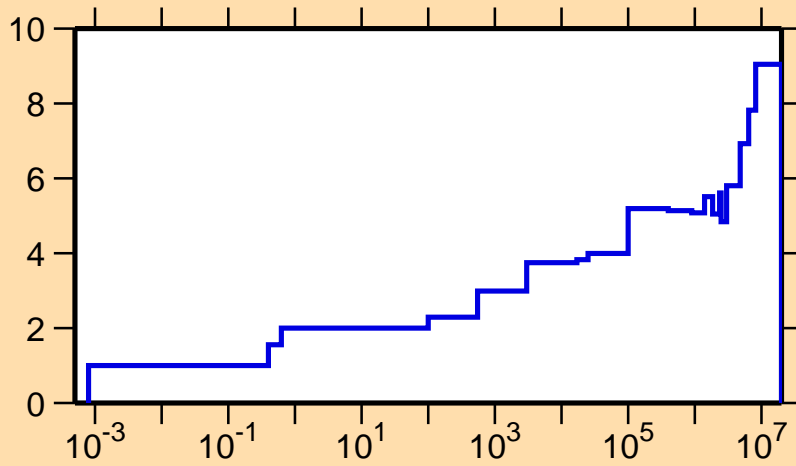

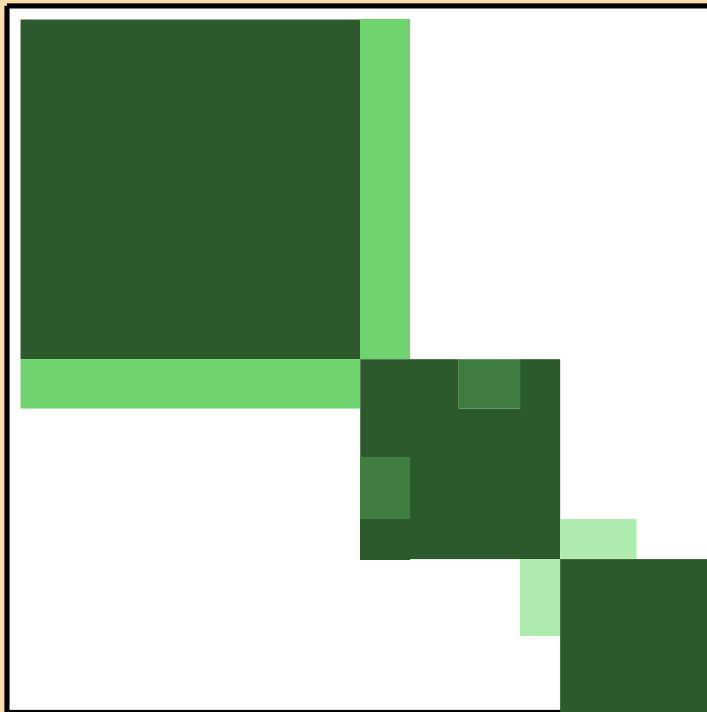
$\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{209}\text{Bi}(n,\text{tot.})$

$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{209}\text{Bi}(n,\text{el.})$

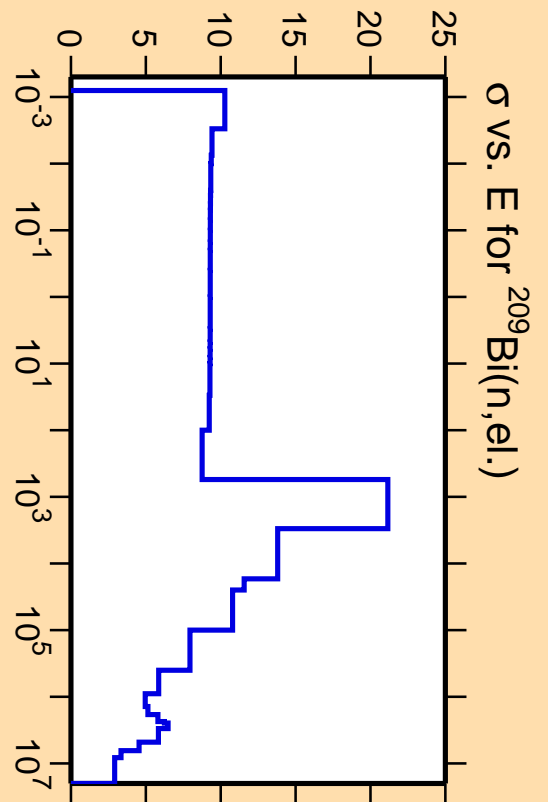

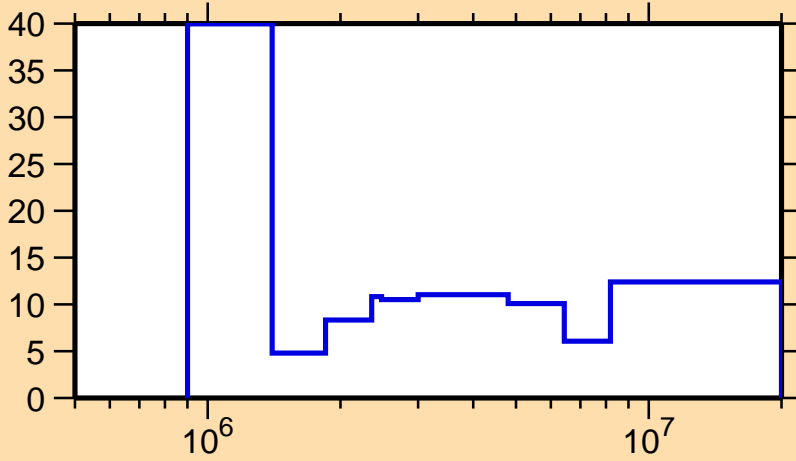

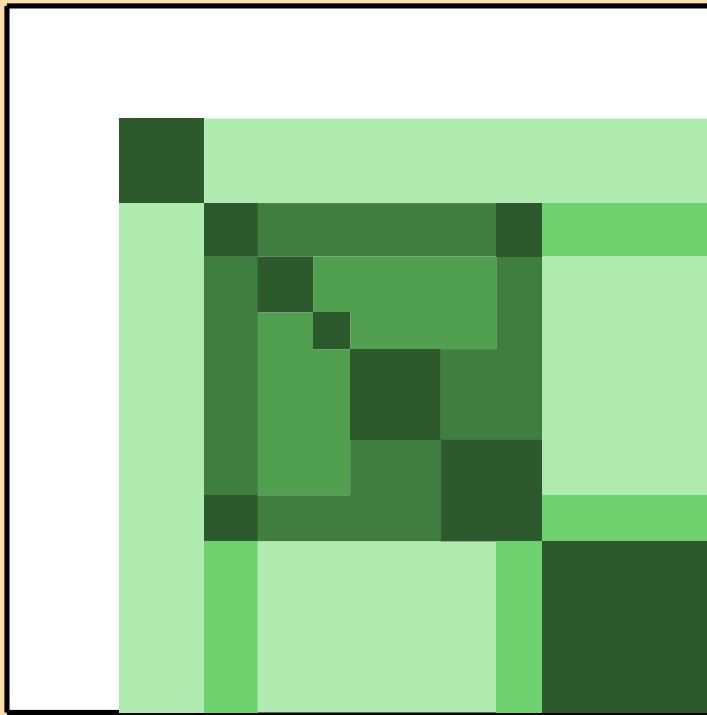
$\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{209}\text{Bi}(n,\text{el.})$

$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{209}\text{Bi}(n,\text{inel.})$

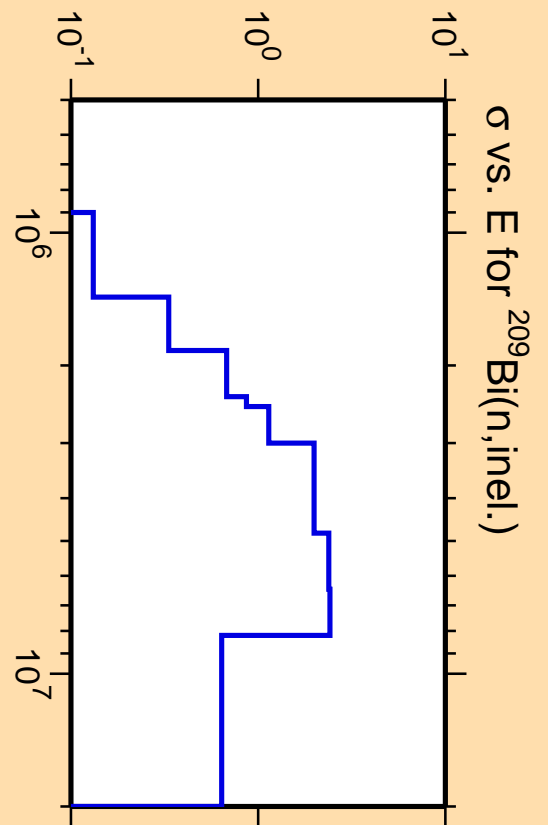

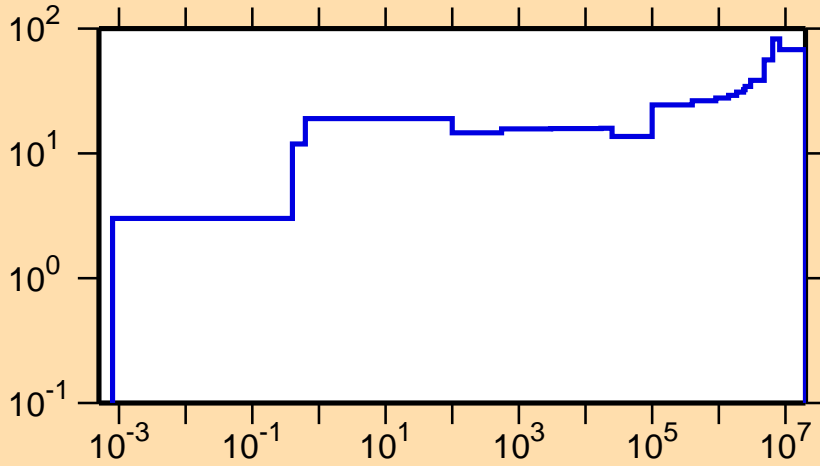

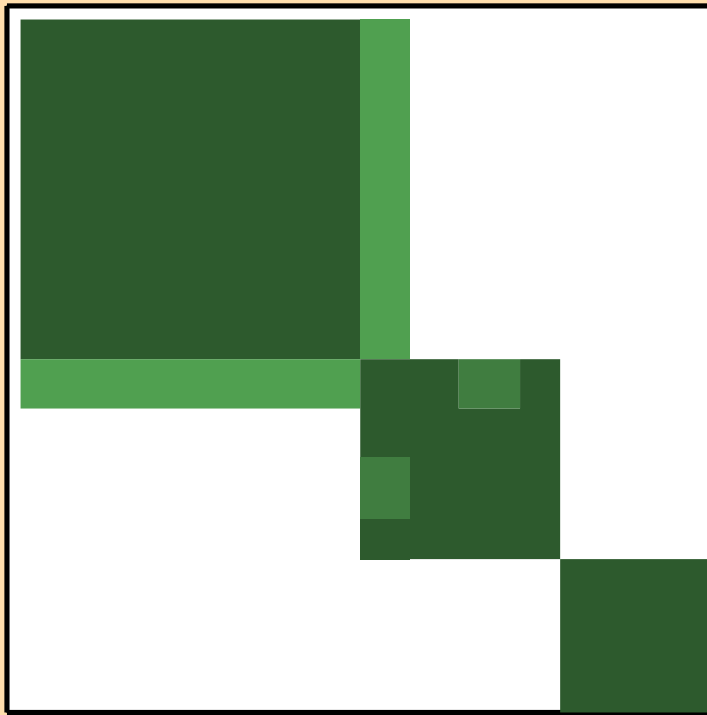
$\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{209}\text{Bi}(n,\text{inel.})$

$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{209}\text{Bi}(n,\gamma)$

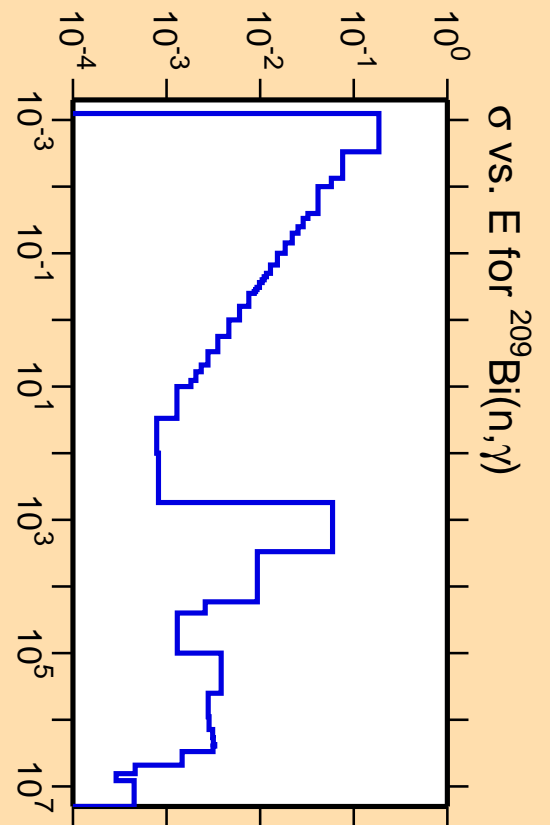
